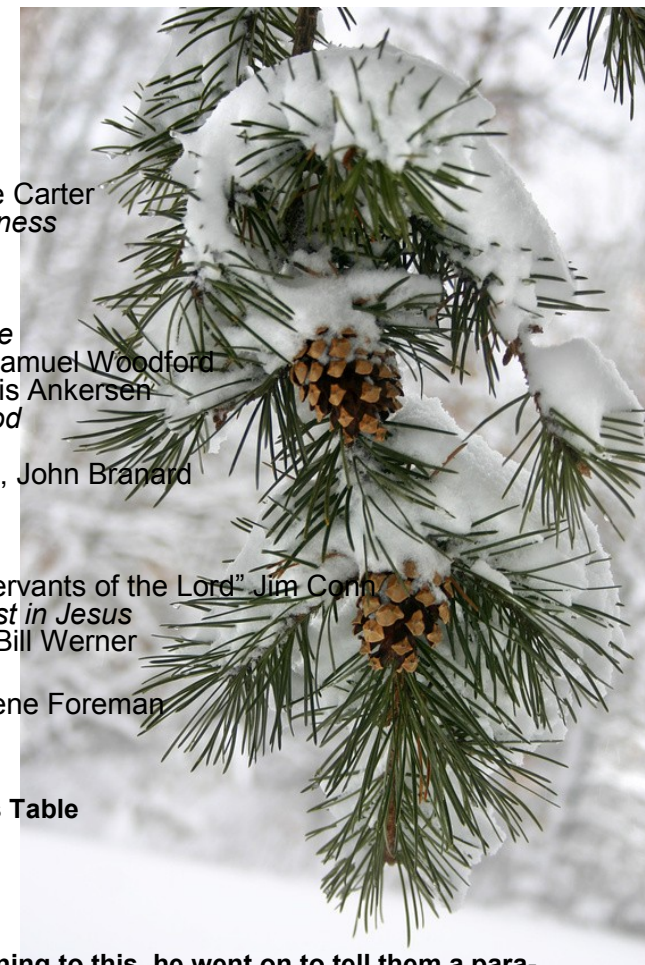

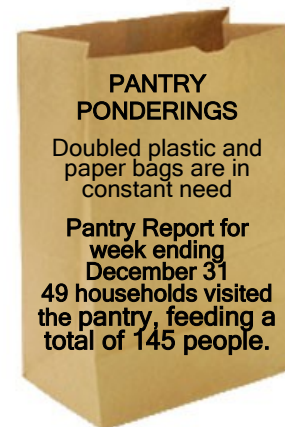
## Ladies Brunch Fellowship
