Last week, 88 visitors came to the food pantry, serving a total of 255 people.

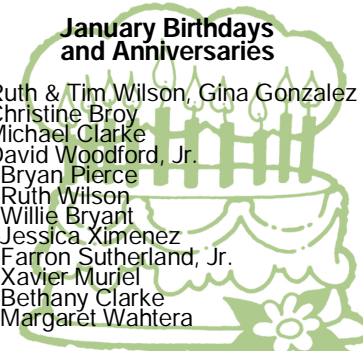
BLANKETS FOR THOSE IN NEED
