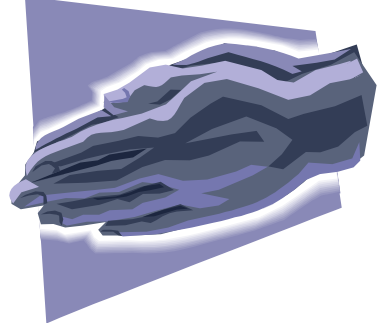

 What does it mean to be a Christian?
 Consider: James 1:27
 I. Christianity requires change, not just adding virtues:
 Titus 2:11-12 - What does it mean to repent?
 This was central to Jesus' message: Mark 1:14-15
 James 1:14 - sin caused by "our own desire"
 Mark 4:14-20; Hebrews 12:1;
 Ecc 4:4: all labor, achievement . . . spring from man's envy of neighbor.
 II. Christianity calls for change, requiring learning
 Do we see Christianity as a learning experience? Phil 4:12-13
 Titus 2:12 - God's grace TEACHES us [educates us]
 III. The type of lives we are called to live and why, Titus 2:12-14
 What is the prudent sensible life?
 What is the reward? 2 Cor 15:21-23
