Thank you so very much.

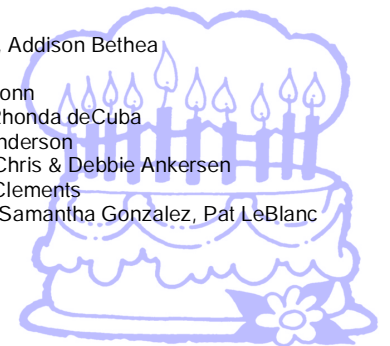
Pantry Report for week ending March 30
