When I came to you, brothers, I did not come with eloquence or superior wisdom as I proclaimed to you the testimony about God. However, as it is written: "No eye has seen, no ear has heard, no mind has conceived what God has prepared for those who love him" – but God has revealed it to us by his Spirit. 1 Corinthians 2:1—10
