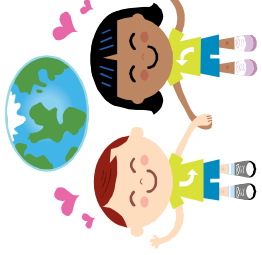


World Bible School

VOLUNTEERS NEEDED

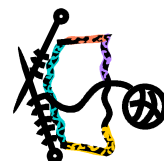
