light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus, his Son, purifies us from all sin.

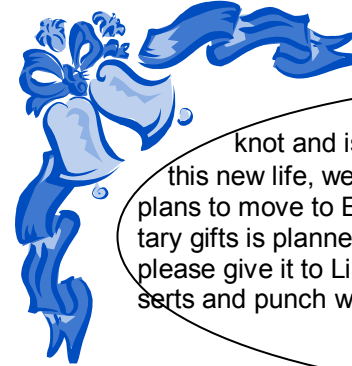

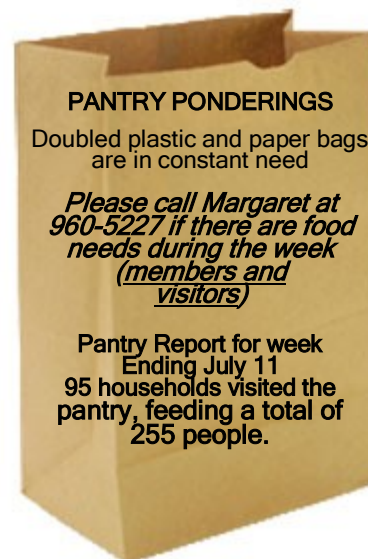
