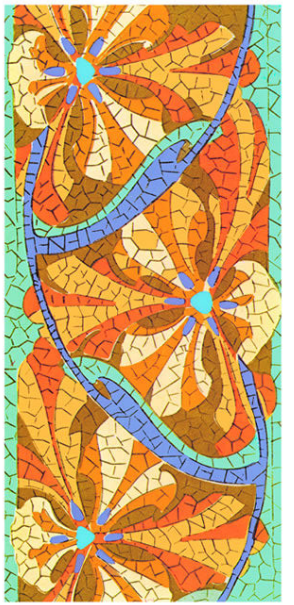
PIERO AND EDITA SUPPORT

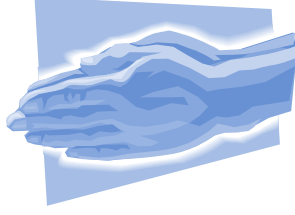
Who Is Jesus—What about the Angels?
