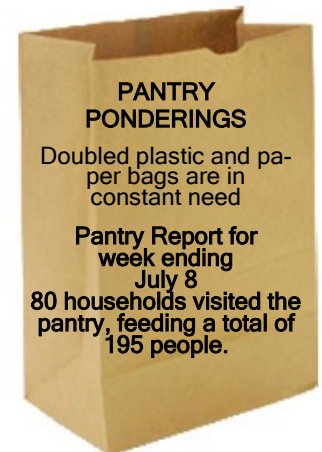
To our family at Oceanside,
