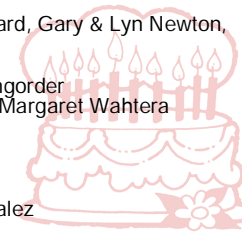

CAMPBELLS LABELS AND BOXTOPS FOR EDUCATION

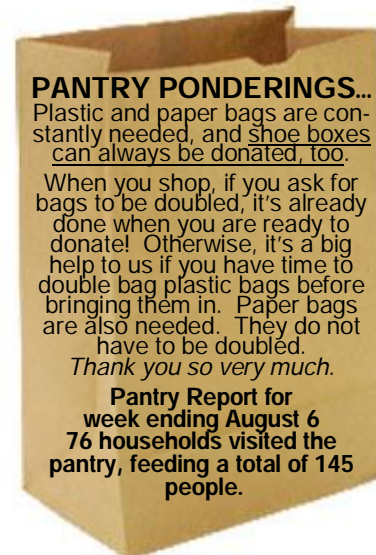
If you do not have a school to collect these for, collect them for Mt. Dora! Give yours to Rita Meredith.

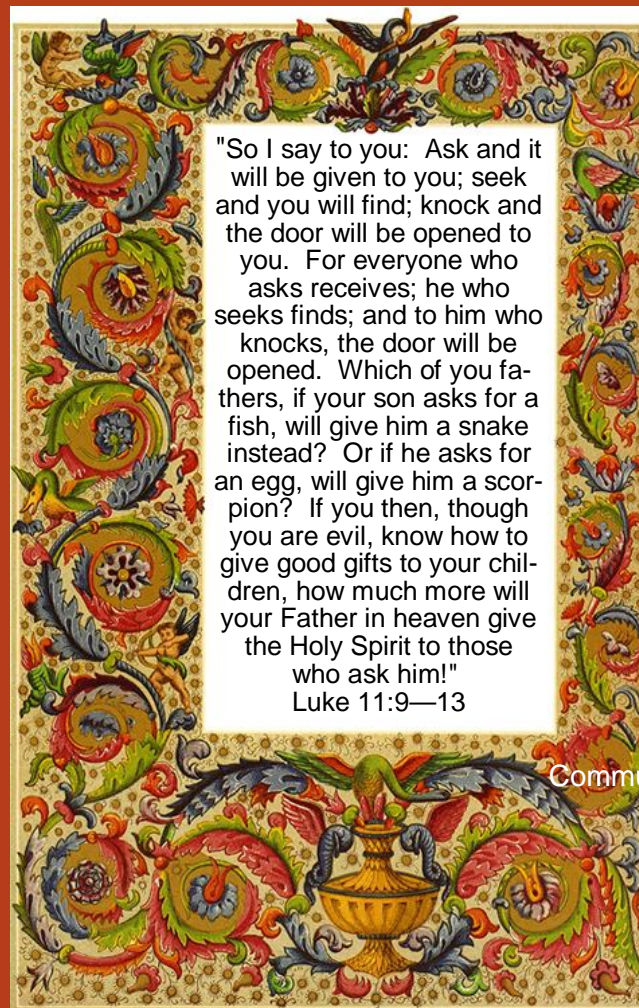
