"Come," he said.

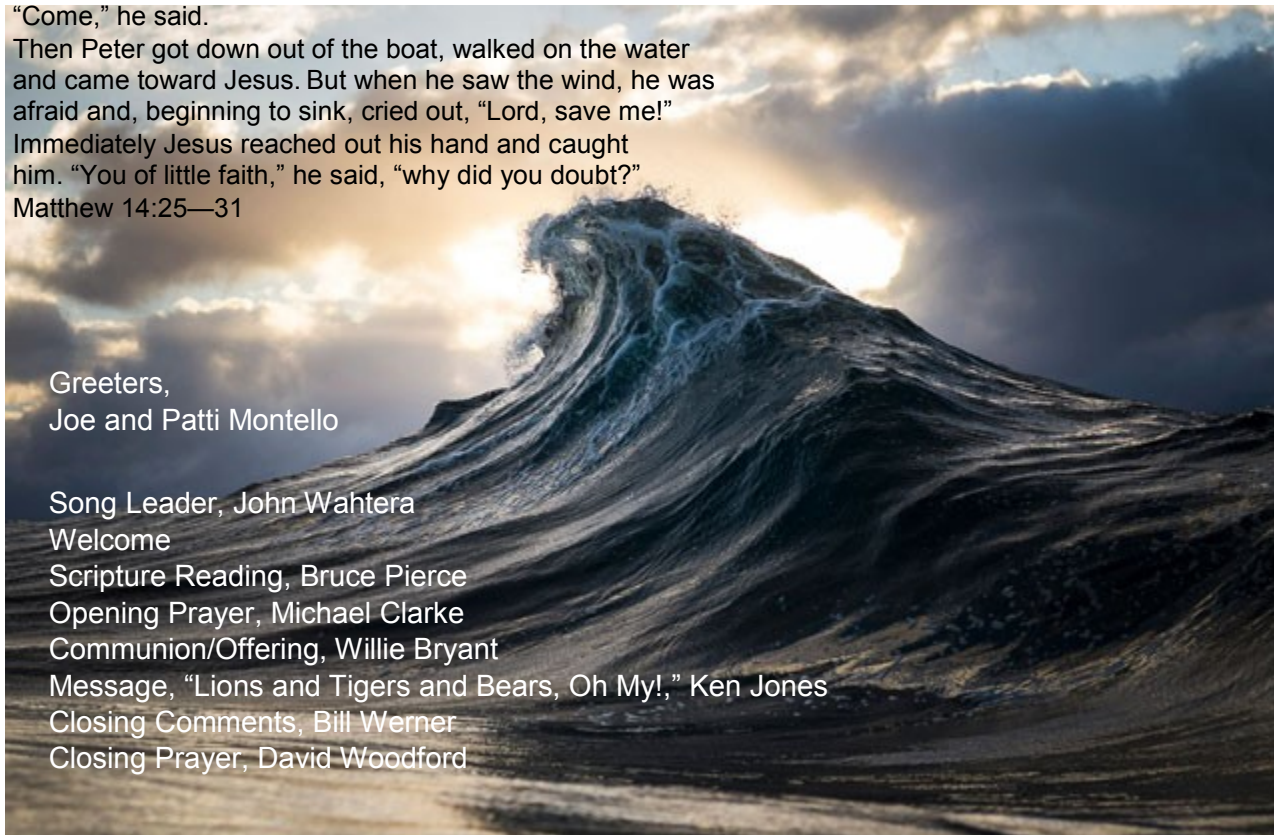
