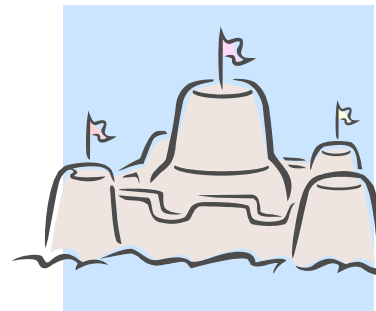

## ALL CHURCH PICNIC - Sunday, September 22, 2013, 12:30 PM

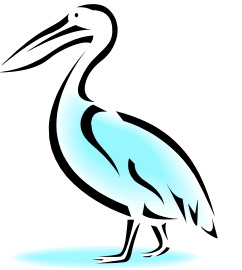
