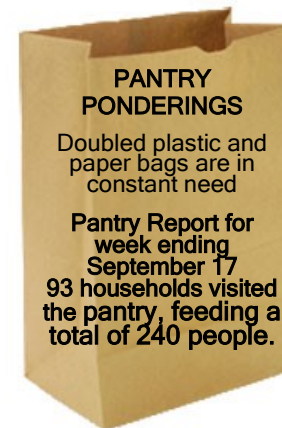
HELP WANTED
