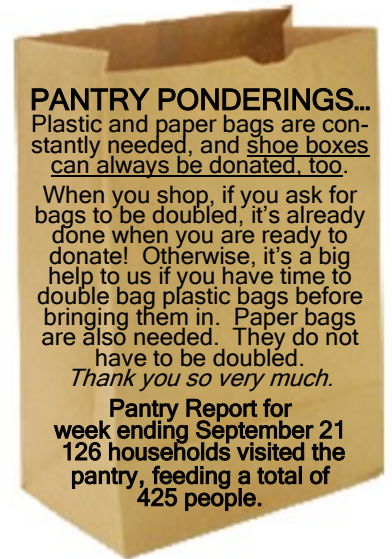
## HURRICANE IRENE DISASTER RELIEF

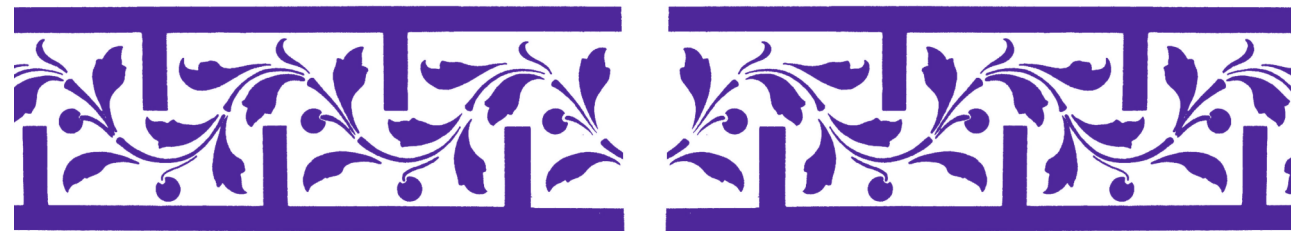
