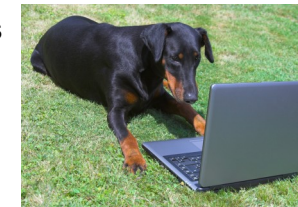
Save the Date

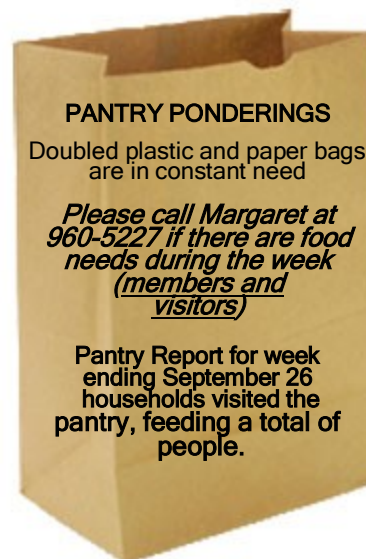
