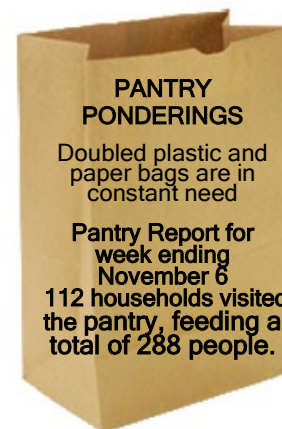


Margaret Wahtera has learned of a need for a twin bed. If there is anyone with one to give away, please contact Margaret and she will make sure it's delivered to the person in need.
