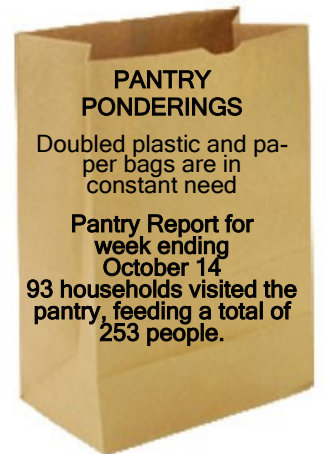
### A Baby Shower!
