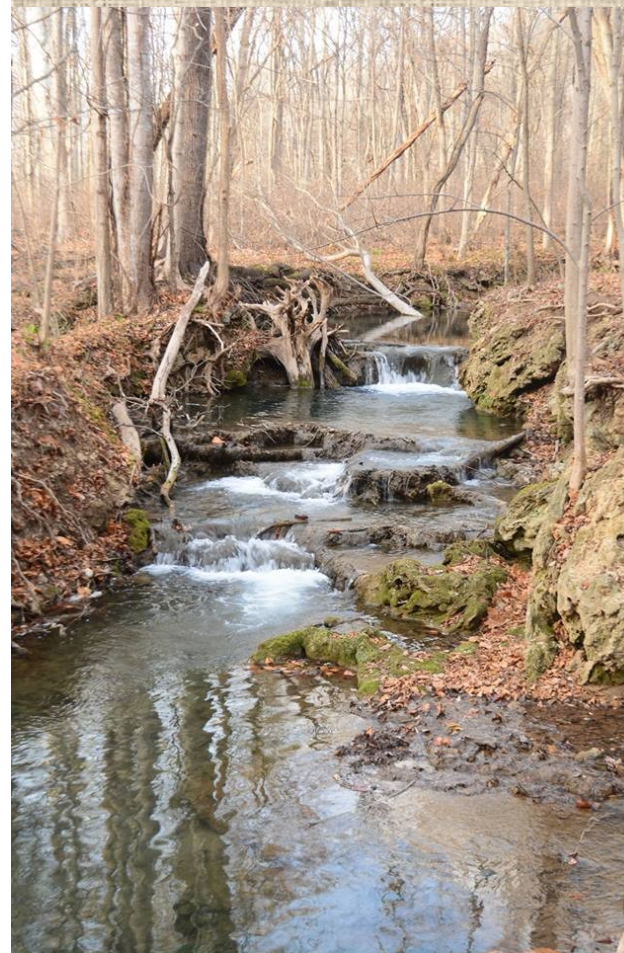

Gift Dignity is a program that harnesses the generosity of the Christmas giving season to provide for Love INC client services in 2017. This is how it works: We will have a small metal tree (about 3' tall) to display in church that has paper ornaments along with an envelope/brochure stand and donation box to display after Thanksgiving through the end of the year. The ornaments give Oceanside the opportunity to give toward Love INC client home repairs, car repairs, Christian counseling, life skills training, and mentorship through our Clearing-house Call Center.
