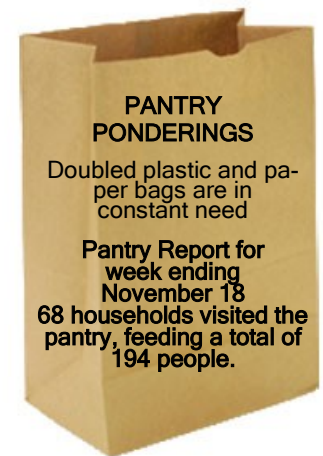
Singles Bible Study - Video Series of Bible Studies
